



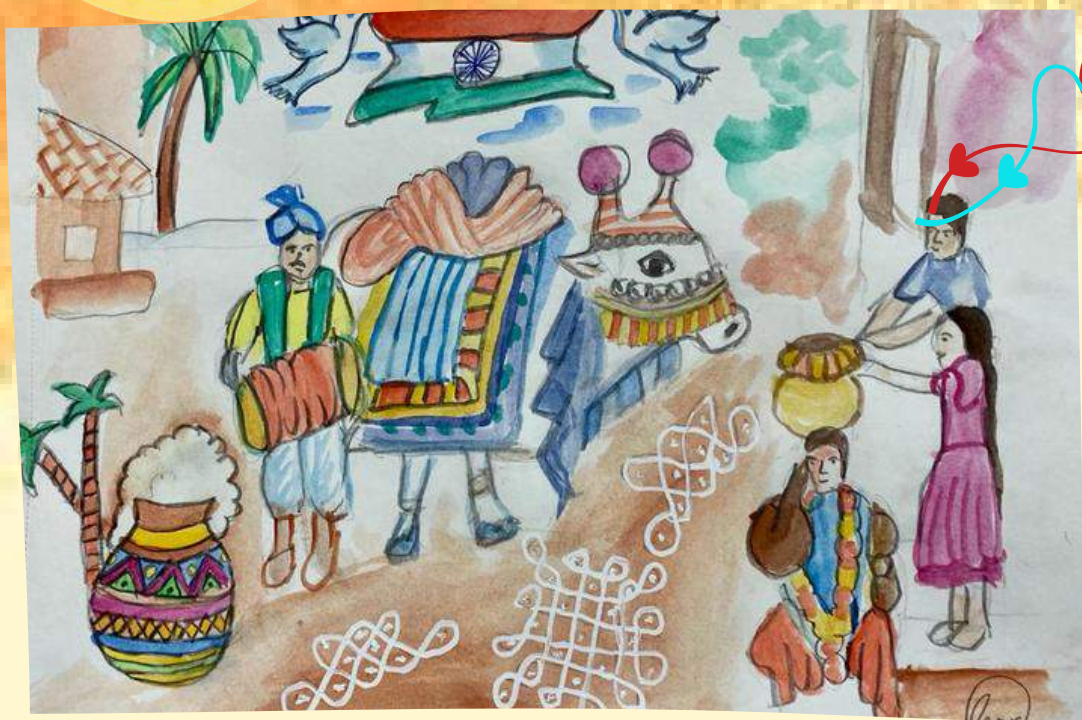

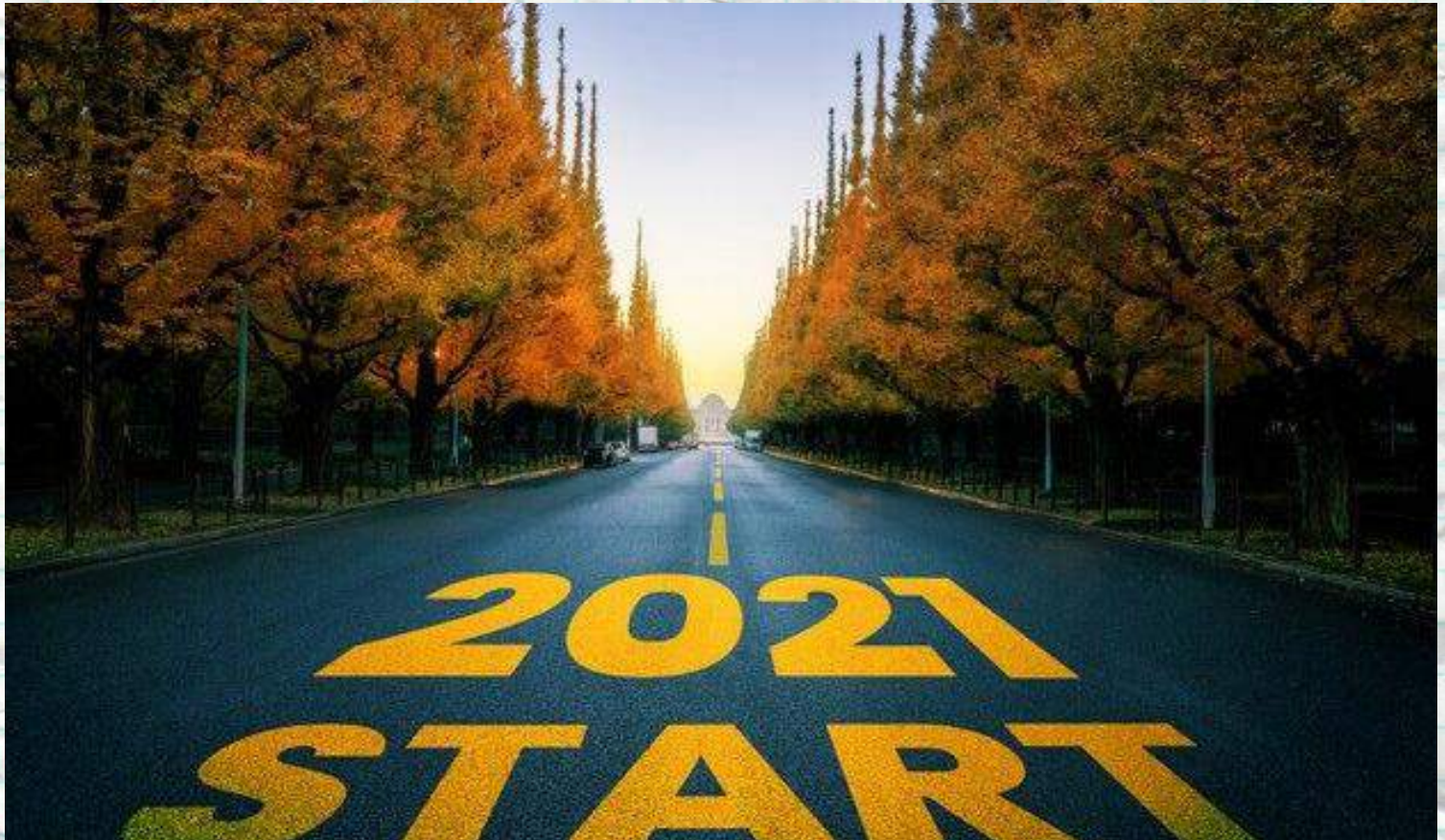




New Year, New Beginnings !!!

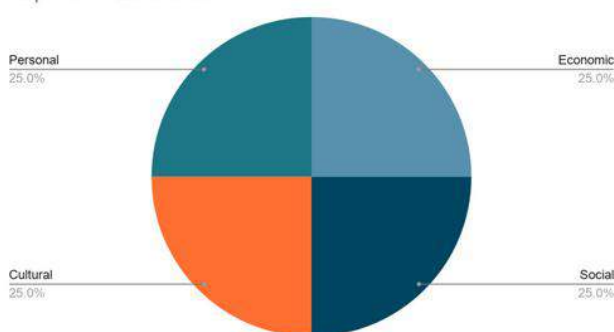

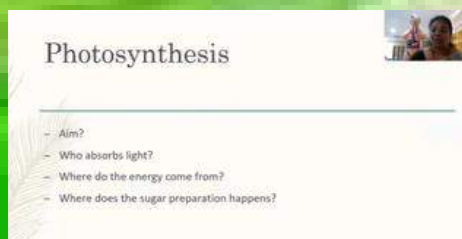


Republic day assembly

Army Day is celebrated every year on January 15th at the parade Ground of Delhi Cantonment.

Army day symbolizes transfer of military power from British to India as Lt. Gen KM Cariappa took over as the first commander in chief from British General Sir Francis Butcher on January 15th, 1949.

The motto of Indian Army is "Service Before Self". In recognition of this motto, the strength, courage and sacrifices of the Indian army men are honored by the Army Chief with bravery and sena medals on this day.

This day is also celebrated with military parades which showcase various aerial stunts and bike pyramids. The parade usually has a different themes and ideas like in 2020, the 'Digital Transformation of Defense' was Indian Army's theme.

To mark the 73rd Army Day in 2021, the Indian Army has organized a marathon – Vijay Run – to commemorate Golden Jubilee (50 years) celebrations of India's resounding victory over Pakistan in 1971.

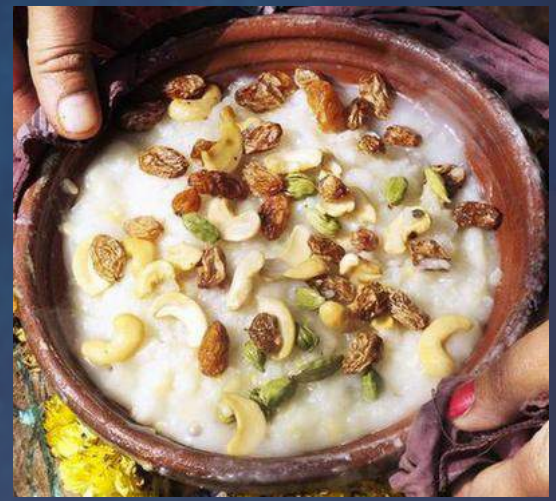

Pongal is a three-day Hindu festival majorly celebrated in south India. It is celebrated in the winters when the sun reaches its southernmost point according to Hindu calculations.

Derived from a Tamil word, Pongal means to boil. Rice is boiled in milk and offered to the sun first and then cows and then to the family and friends.

Food for Pongal is cooked under the sun in clay pots. The basic ingredients are some freshly-harvested rice and milk; other than that, we include ghee, cardamom, raisins, and cashew nuts.

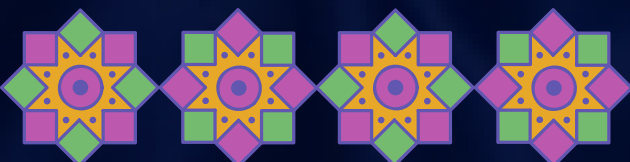

Then, put it on in the grill toaster and let it grill for 5 minutes.

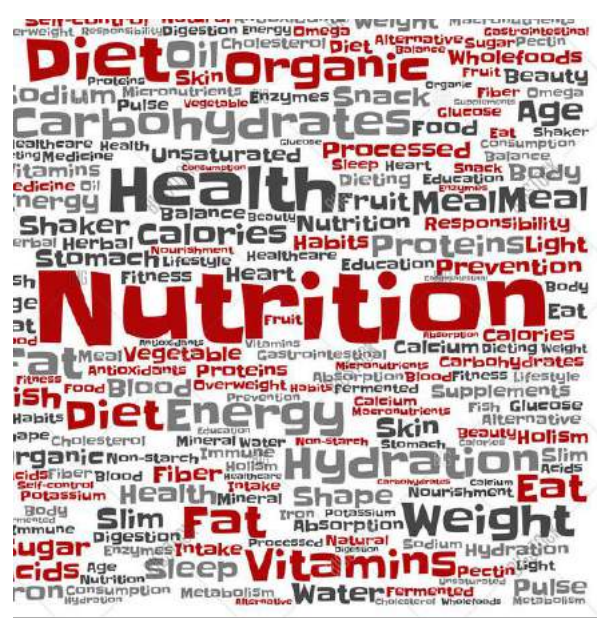
Finally, cut it into half and the yummy cheese sandwich is ready.

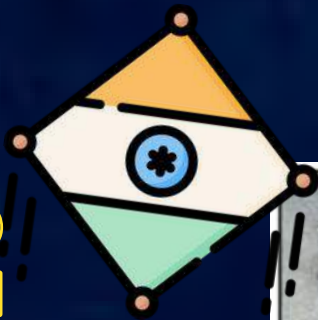
